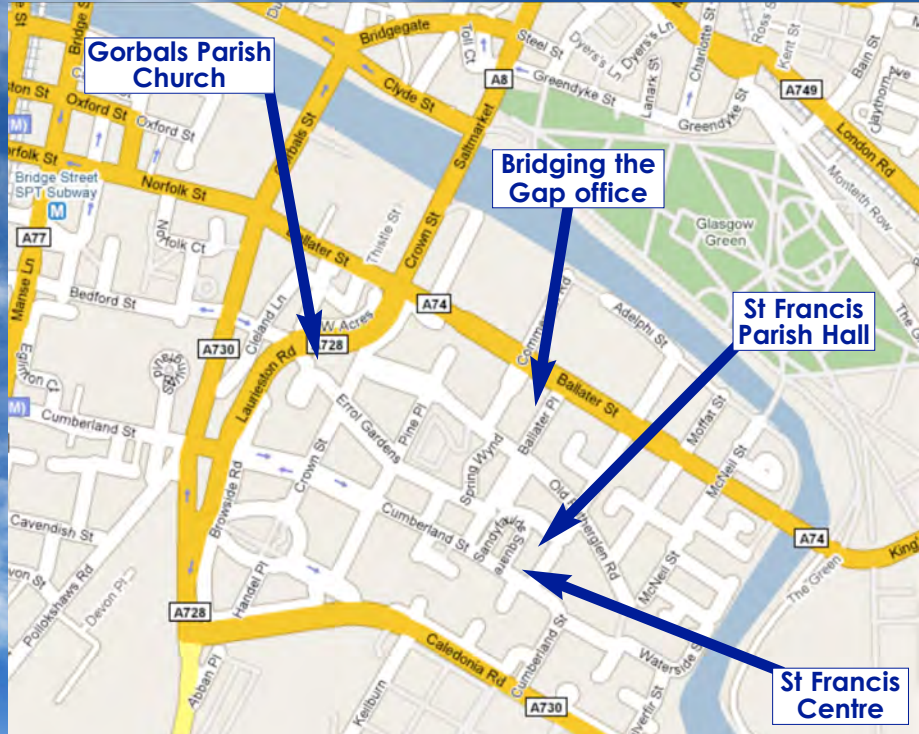
We are a charity based in the Gorbals which gives people opportunities to get together and find common ground.
